

Re-opening

As it stands currently, we are working on the basis that we will be opening to the whole school at the end of August as planned. We do not currently know what restrictions will be in place but we envisage a 'bubble' approach to classes, where social distancing within classes is minimised but classes cannot mix with each other. This will bring more organisational changes which we will announce nearer to re-opening. This would also impact on the potential opening of our new Wrap Around Care as bubbles would not be able to mix.
