RSE Parent Consultation – Summary of Findings (22 Responses)

We recently consulted parents on our Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) policy. Thank you to everyone who responded.

Key Findings

- 69% of parents are familiar with the RSE policy.
- 95% say the curriculum is clearly set out by year group.
- 91% feel our teaching approach is appropriate.
- 91% believe content is age appropriate.
- 64% feel well informed about RSE provision.
- 55% would welcome additional guidance to support discussions at home.

What Parents Told Us

Most parents are supportive of the school's RSE provision. A small number requested:

- Greater clarity around lesson detail
- Confirmation of how consent is taught
- Information about whether boys and girls are taught together
- Increased communication and visibility of updates

What We Will Do Next

- Provide a clear parent summary of RSE content
- Share resources to support conversations at home
- Clarify how parents can view teaching materials
- Continue to emphasise consent, online safety and respectful relationships

We value our partnership with families and will continue to ensure our RSE provision is transparent, age-appropriate and supportive of all pupils.
